### **Background**

San Diego Police Chief Shelley Zimmerman stated publicly that within the last three years San Diego's legal marijuana dispensaries have generated 272 calls for service from police for burglaries, robberies, thefts, assaults and shootings.

Any and all records related to the San Diego Police Department's ("SDPD") consultation with Colorado officials regarding the availability of cannabis, including but not limited to, records of communication between SDPD and Colorado officials regarding cannabis, any documents shared between Colorado officials and SDPD regarding cannabis, any notes from meetings held between SDPD and Colorado officials regarding cannabis, any reports generated from the meetings between Colorado and SDPD, etc.
